

Centennial Family Forest



- To qualify as a Centennial Family Forest, the land must currently be certified as a Tree Farm and/or Stewardship Forest.
- The land must have been in family ownership for at least 100 years (although it does not have to be forested the entire time)
- An owner of the tract must submit the following information to the Arkansas Forestry Association
 - Description of the property (number of acres and location)
 - Short history of the property (ownership details and how the land has been used)
- Recipient will receive a Centennial Family Forest recognition certificate.
- Recipient is eligible to receive outdoor signs. The metal sign is white with green ink and the cost is \$20 for AFA members, \$45 for non-members. Additional signs are \$10.50 each. Recipient agrees to allow a photograph to be taken of the owner(s) along with the sign for program publicity. The sign says *Centennial Family Forest. 100 Years and Growing.*
- The sign should be erected with the Tree Farm and/or Stewardship sign.
