### In-service Credit

### Date and Location

TCT will be held Tuesday through Thursday, July 6-9, at the Lake Point Conference Center near Russellville. Participants will stay in lodging rooms at the conference center.

### Eligibility

Formal and nonformal educators of grades K through 12 may apply. Space is limited to 25 participants, so register TODAY!

The AFA Education Foundation covers all food, lodging and tour transportation costs. A \$100 reservation fee is required at the time of application (refundable if you cancel two weeks in advance of the tour). You must provide your own transportation to and from Russellville.
