The Arkansas Prescribed Fire Council is conducting a prescribed burn workshop for woodland owners at 9 a.m. on Saturday, February 11.

The workshop will help woodland owners understand the factors that influence effective and safe burns.

Classroom time will address:

- fire planning
- fire behavior
- ignition techniques
- weather and smoke
- using fire for forest and quail management

There will be a prescribed burn demonstration (weather permitting). Space is limited, so register early. *A \$20 fee covers materials, breaks and lunch.* Participants should dress for the field exercise.

Directions: From Hwy. 67, take Exit 55 (Bald Knob) and follow Hwy. 167 N toward Batesville for 34 miles. After crossing the river, continue north to the Hwy. 69 bypass at the 6th traffic light. Turn left onto the Hwy. 69 bypass and travel approximately two miles and then merge right onto Hwy. 69 North. Proceed seven miles to the intersection of Hwy. 106. Turn left onto Hwy. 106. Go south three miles on Hwy. 106, then turn left onto Experiment Station Drive.
